Condition of Sanction: The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4). The copy of such certification is on file with USA Swimming.

- Type of Meet:** Closed Meet
25 Yard Short Course
6 & Under Timed Finals, Relay Timed Finals
8 & Under, 10 & Under, 11-12, 13-14, 15-18 preliminaries, finals and consolation finals.
Championship finals will be swum prior to consolation finals.
- Date and Time:** Saturday and Sunday June 12 & 13, 2010
Prelim Session will begin at 9:00 AM, Saturday and Sunday
6&U Session will begin Sunday, 15 minutes after prelim session ends. 6&U warm-ups will begin in warmup/warmdown lanes during prelim session.
Finals will begin at 5:00 PM on Saturday and 4:30 PM on Sunday
Warm-up for morning prelims begins at 7:30 am both days.
Warm-up for finals begins 4:00pm Saturday and 3:30pm Sunday.
- Eligibility** Open to all registered USA Swimming athletes who are members of invited summer teams in good standing with the Private Club League
- Location:** North Shore Pool
901 North Shore Drive NE
St. Petersburg, FL 33701
- Pool Specifications:** Certified 25 Yard, outdoor pool with a maximum of 20 short course racing lanes having a minimum depth of 4 feet, at both starting ends, and non-turbulent lane lines.
10 lanes for prelims and timed-final events. 8 lanes for finals. Numerous lanes for constant warm-up.
- Timing:** Colorado Timing System with scoreboard.
- Warm-up:** General warm-up: 7:30 AM for Saturday and Sunday prelims
Warm-up for 6&U Session will start in the warm-up lanes during the Prelim Session.
One hour warm-up prior to each Final Session - 4pm for Saturday and 3:30 for Sunday.
- Finals:** Each Championship Final will be swum first so that vacancies can be filled from the Consolation Final. Consolation Final qualifiers are asked to be at the designated block to be considered for any vacancies in Championship Final. Alternate Final qualifiers are asked to be standing behind Starter at the time of the Consolation Final.

- Seeding:** 25 yard short course times will be used for seeding.
- Entry Limit:** Limited to (3) three individual events and (2) two relays per swimmer
Each team may enter only one relay team per event.
Over entries will automatically be dropped when they exceed the meet limit.
- Entry Form:** Entries must be submitted on HyTek export format accompanied by a hard copy and payment. Teams choosing to submit entries in hard copy form only will be charged an additional \$50.00. Entries will be accepted via e-mail to eva@swimresultsbytrg.com.
E-Mail entries must be accompanied by a backup hard copy of the entry, list of all attending coaches, contact phone numbers, and a summary of financial information as outlined on the Master Entry Form. Current USA Swimming registration number, full name, age, and entry time must be listed. All entry and Master Entry Forms must be signed.

\$7.50 facility fee per swimmer
- Entry Deadline:** Entries must be received via email by Thursday June 3, 2010.

Checks made payable to "CCCA Swim Team" must accompany the entry.
- Warm Up Procedures:** Absolutely no equipment at any time. Swimmers must enter the water feet first with at least one hand in contact with the pool deck, except when executing a controlled racing start, supervised by a coach.
- Scratches:** PRELIMS: No penalty for scratches on the blocks.
FINALS: Any swimmer who competes in a preliminary heat and qualifies in the top 16 as originally seeded, must swim in that event's final or consolation final; or must submit their intention to scratch from that event within 30 minutes of the announcement of qualifiers. Swimmers may reverse their intention to scratch and choose to be seeded for finals if they do so within 30 minutes of their last event of the day. Any swimmer seeded in a final who fails to swim that event will be barred from further competition in the meet, unless excused by the Meet Referee because of illness or emergency. The Meet Referee must be notified prior to the event taking place. Coaches are encouraged to scratch swimmers seeded in the top 24 if not returning for finals. If there is an open lane in the Championship finals, the fastest qualifier in consolation finals will be offered that lane. Designated alternates wishing to swim in open lanes in consolation finals must check in with the deck referee and stand at the starters table ready to swim when the swimmers are called to the blocks. Only the starter may call for alternates.
- Scoring:** Individual Finals: 20-17-16-15-14-13-12-11
Consolations: 9-7-6-5-4-3-2-1

(6 & Under Individual events will be scored to 16 places)
Relays: Finals: 40-34-32-30-28-26-24-22

- Awards:** Individual Events: 1st - 3rd Medals, 4th - 8th Rosettes, 9th - 16th Ribbons
Relay Events: 1st - 3rd Medals, 4th - 8th Custom Ribbons
Team: 1st - 3rd Trophies for Combined Team
High Point: 1st - 3rd award for girls and boys each age group

- Rules:** 2010 USA Swimming Rules and PCL By-Laws will govern the Meet. A declared false start under 102.14.5D or deliberate delay of meet under 102.14.7A is not permitted and will be regarded as a failure to compete.

NO PARENT'S OR SPECTATORS ARE ALLOWED ON DECK UNLESS THEY ARE WORKING TIMERS OR CHAPERONES WITH PASSES.

- Identification:** Coaches and Officials shall wear their USA Swimming registration card in a conspicuous location at all times while on deck during a swim meet.
- Team Rep:** Prior to the start of the meet, the name of one person, other than the Coach, who will check with the referee about any matters pertaining to the meet, may be given to the referee. For each team, the Coach and that person ONLY will be recognized.
- Volunteers:** Each team must provide 3 timers for Prelims and Finals both Saturday and Sunday and for the 6&U session. Teams must submit a list of timers by June 4th via email to: ianoneil71@yahoo.com

Each team will be allowed chaperones on the pool deck for their swimmers. Teams with 50 or less swimmers will be allowed 4 chaperones and teams with 50 or more swimmers will be allowed 8 chaperones. For the 6&U session, small teams will have 2, large teams will have 4 chaperones. CCCA will provide lanyards with id badges for each chaperone.

Each team will be provided with complimentary heat sheets for coaches and chaperones. Teams must submit a list of chaperones by June 4th via email to: ianoneil71@yahoo.com.
